The band undoubtedly became one of the most popular cover bands on the coast, scoring big gigs with Kevin Borich, The Radiators and Angry Anderson. In the year 2000 Dave formed the rock duo "The Goods". After moving away from the Central Coast in 03 Dave decided to embark on solo performances in the Newcastle and Hunter regions.

BEN ROTH

Ben Roth began his live stage experience with guest appearances with hard rock band Damaged Goods as lead guitarist back in 98. His dazzling playing style impressed audiences and the experience he gained was invaluable. In 99 Ben took over bass guitar duties for the band and gigged hard with the band until their final show in 2000. Up until 07 Damaged Goods has reformed once a year for the American Motorcycle Club and has performed at their rallies to raise money for various charities. In 01 Ben hooked up with Anita Tressider to form a rock pop duo Fun2mental, the duo has been well received all over the Newcastle and Central Coast regions, but after 6 years Ben felt there was a change of direction needed.
